

# OVERVIEW


Covering 54 per cent of Western Australia, Australia's Golden Outback region stretches from the rugged red earth of Mt Augustus and Kennedy Ranges in the north to the sweeping snow-white beaches of Esperance and the South Coast.

At the very heart of Western Australia's Golden Outback lies the modern mining hub of Kalgoorlie and the Goldfields, offering fascinating insights into the history and heritage of the wild gold rush days. And in the Wheatbelt to the west, picturesque rolling farmland is dotted with colourful rural townships, granite outcrops, farm stays and Wave Rock.

Australia's Golden Outback region provides diverse outback tourism opportunities, epic road trips, fascinating nature, wildlife and cultural experiences. The natural landscape is a dazzling display of outback plains, huge deserts and salt lakes, rugged rocky outcrops, wild woodland and some of the whitest beaches in the world. Spring time transforms the region with a rainbow of blooming Western Australian wildflowers.





#### **ROAD TO THE ROCK**

• 9 Days. Sealed and unsealed roads

You'll find an abundance of white-sand beaches, rugged national parks and the clearest ocean water. Esperance is just over 700km from Perth and the drive to get here is one EPIC road trip!

#### KINGSFORD SMITH MAIL RUN

• 3 Davs. Unsealed roads

Hit the Kingsford Smith Mail Run in your 4WD and head north on an outback camping adventure, following the original overland mail run to the magnificent Mt Augustus. This trail takes you from Carnarvon on the Coral Coast, inland to the historic gold mining town of Meekatharra.

#### **WOOL WAGON PATHWAY**

This self-drive trail takes you from Geraldton through the Gascoyne Murchison up to Exmouth in the Coral Coast. The drive takes you through historic and timeless towns like Pindar and Murchison Settlement whilst showcasing the real Aussie landscape.

#### **MINERS PATHWAY**



This trail takes you from Paynes Find to Meekatharra, or from Yalgoo to Sandstone. Venture along the Miners Pathway and explore the wild prospecting towns that rocketed to the forefront of Western Australia's gold rush in the 1800s.

#### **CANNING STOCK ROUTE**

The Canning Stock Route is an internationally recognised 'Iconic Journey of Australia'. The remote trail runs from Halls Creek in the Kimberley region of Western Australia to Wiluna in the Northern Goldfields.


